





TEST for HIV?

- Are you unsure about having been at risk of HIV or have you been tested for STDs, but not for HIV?
- Has your GP or specialist given you a diagnosis that is on the list of HIV indicator conditions, but you have not been tested for HIV yet?

Read here about how you can still request an HIV test and we will help you with how to ask your GP or specialist for having this done.

Open the discussion by, for example:

'I would like to discuss something with vou'

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Choose the option that suits you best:

- A I don't think I was tested for HIV during my last STD test.
- B I read about HIV indicator disorders on the #aware.hiv site. The diagnosis Leukopenia or thrombocytopenia is such an HIV indicator condition. I don't think I've been tested for HIV yet.
- C The symptoms I've had lately could be related to an HIV infection. I would like to discuss with you if you agree that my symptoms could indicate a possible HIV infection.
